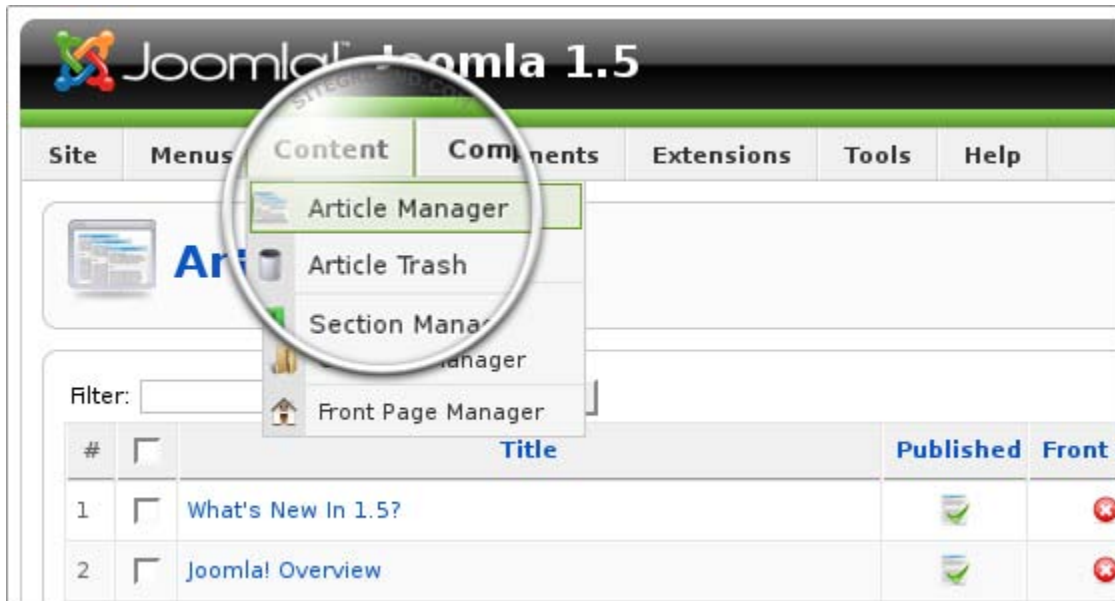


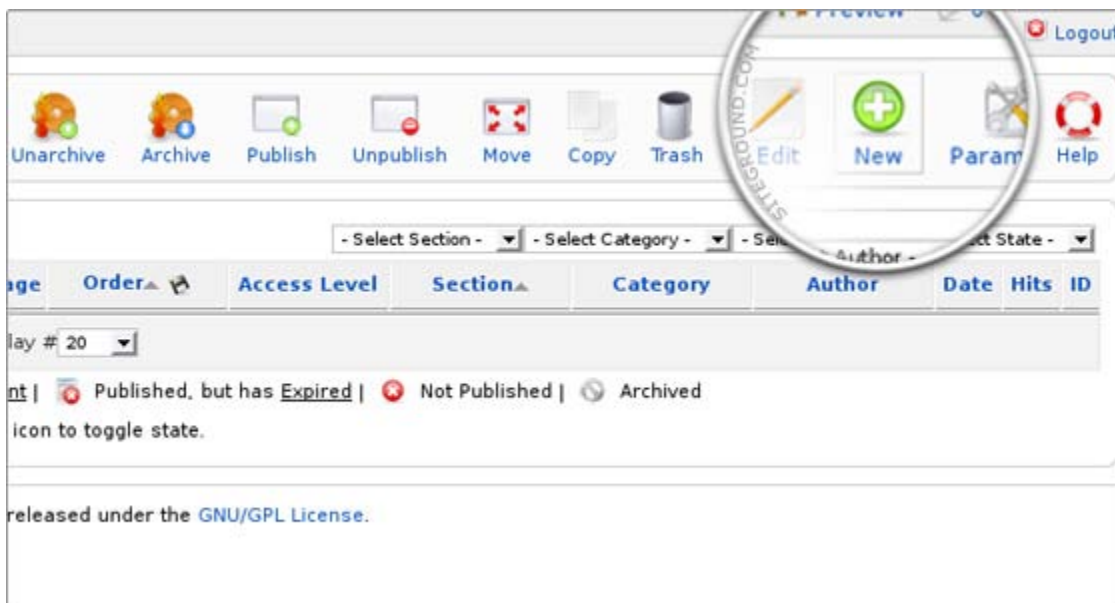
Creating A New Page/Article

You will not be creating new pages for your website unless you are adding articles to a category list page that has already been created for you. If you need a new page on your site otherwise, please contact Turtle Island Creative to assist you.

Go to **Content > Article Manager** from the top admin menu.



»Step 1. From the top admin menu click on [New].



✎ Step 2. Then make the following changes in the corresponding fields:

Title: Title your page so you will know what it is.

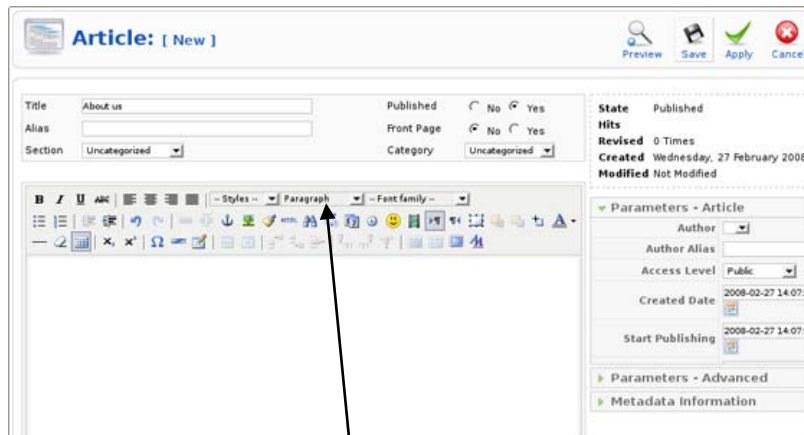
Alias: (leave it blank)

Section: Choose section that has been created for you.

Category: Choose category that has been created for you.

Published: Yes (If the article is not published, it will not be shown to your visitors. It will remain only as a draft.)

Frontpage: No



In the main text field write your page copy. Assign a style to each section of your text. Use the drop menu above to apply the following tags that have ALREADY BEEN ASSIGNED by me when I created your site. This is **IMPORTANT**. If you start applying different fonts and colors to your text, it will lose the professional look of the site. Adhere to the styles listed below, and your site will retain a professional, quality look.

- Select “paragraph” for your text.
- Select “H1” for your page titles.
- Select “H2 – H3” for subheads on your pages.
